I am directed to refer to the application dated 10.09.2018 of the Govt. Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital seeking the grant of permission of the Central Government to start BHMS Course with 100 seats each for the academic session 2019-20 under Section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973.

2. After careful consideration of your proposal in terms of the provision of the HCC Act 1973, relevant regulations, inspection report and recommendation of the CCH; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the State Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital for starting New Homeopathic Medical College in the name and style of “State Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Gorakhpur” with 100 seats in BHMS Course under 12 A of HCC Act, 1973, for the academic session 2019-20.
3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and other requirements as per the provision of HCC (MSR), 2013 Regulations are in position before the admission of the first batch of students with 100 seats, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.
4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2<sup>nd</sup> BHMS course well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional session and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
5. It is further informed that 15% of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. The

Admission to the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central Counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

7. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from date of issue of this permission letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

8. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P.No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

9. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2020-21 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.



2. As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, as per NCH Act 2020 and its relevant regulations.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-I proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed shortfalls in the college have been discussed with the principal during online hearing. The college has been called for an online hearing on dated 10/10/2022 and the deficiencies were persisting there in the time of hearing too. Further, the college has submitted the compliance report and affidavit from Director, AYUSH stating that all shortfalls will be rectified in the shortest possible time.

After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 and its relevant regulations **permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to State Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Barhalganj, Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh – 273402 for student intake of 125 UG seats (including EWS quota) for BHMS course for the academic year 2022-23.**


All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

The college has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act, 2020 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed, has to be rectified within 30 days' time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and


Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance.

Sir/Madam,

State Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Gorakhpur is functional since 2019 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 125 seats in BHMS course including EWS for the academic year 2023-24. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020. As per 29(3) of NCH, Act 2020 your college was given an opportunity for being heard on the shortfalls intimated to them vide hearing letter F.No.-4-7/2023-24/NCH (MA&RBH) (122-12)/601 dated 26/07/2023.

MARBH has examined the submissions made by the College during physical hearing held on 07/08/2023 and the report of physical hearing was forwarded to the College vide letter dated 10/08/2023. The College is directed to maintain the essential standards to impart quality education in Homoeopathy and maintain the following measures in the Collegiate Hospital:

- Case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as name, age sex, address, phone number with complete case analysis, evaluation and repertorisation. These documents and follow up attendance of patients shall be made available in the medical record room for academic purposes of students.
- Lab investigation reports should be maintained properly in case records.
- Disease diagnosis shall be recorded in all case records as per ICD 11 criteria.


On perusal of the documents submitted by the College during physical hearing held on 07/08/2023 and report of Committee, MARBH observed that the College is not fulfilling the required Faculties and Staff for Collegiate Hospital. Shortfalls persisting with the College was communicated to the College vide MARBH letter no. F. No.4-7/2023-24/NCH(MARBH)(122-11)/1134-1136 dated 10/08/2023. The above shortfalls observed in the College shall be rectified within a period of 30 days or before the first day of counselling for admissions whichever is earlier.

Considering the steps taken by the State Government for appointing the required faculties and staff for the Collegiate Hospital, and facilities available with the College, MARBH has decided to issue conditional permission to State Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Gorakhpur with admission intake capacity of 125 seats (including EWS quota seats) for Undergraduate (BHMS) course for academic year 2023 - 24.

It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 125 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government/NCH for the A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCH for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Govt. for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder. The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the MARBH after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by MARBH.

State Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Gorakhpur-273402 Uttar Pradesh is functional since 2017 and has applied for permission for sanction of UG course with 125 seats including EWS quota for the academic year 2024-25. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board have examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the application, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board have observed the following shortfalls as per MSR requirements:

- Teaching staff:** The college is facing lack of staff in Department of Physiology, Organon of Medicine, Pharmacy, Forensic Medicine, Practice of Medicine, Gynae and Obs, Repertory, Community Medicine
- Hospital staff:** Medical Superintendent, Senior Medical Officer, Residential Medical Officer, Surgeon (General Surgeon), Anesthetist, Obstetrician/ Gynecologist, Radiologist, Pathologist/ Biochemist, House Physician, Lab Technician, X-ray Technician/ Radiographer are not appointed.
- Miscellaneous:** College has not enabled the Aadhar Enabled Biometric Attendance system (AEBAS). The same may be implemented in one month of time.

The Principal of the college has informed that Govt. has taken steps to fill up vacancies of Guest faculties, Part time faculties and Regular faculties in all departments.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, Medical assessment and Rating board has decided to issue Conditional Permission to State Homoeopathic Medical college and Hospital, Gorakhpur-273402 Uttar Pradesh for conducting UG course with 125 seats including EWS quota for the academic year 2024-2025 regarding.


All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

All admissions shall be made for NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the intake capacity of 125 UG seats including EWS shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government /NCH for the A.Y 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of the State/UT.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.
