Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take certain time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy.

- A. **Hospital Staff:** Medical superintendent 01, senior medical officer 01, resident medical officer 02, General surgeon 01, anesthetist on call, Gynecologist 01, Radiologist on call, Pathologist/Biochemist 01, House Physician 02, Dispenser 01, Laboratory Technician 01, X-ray technician/Radiographer on call, X-ray attendant on call, Nursing staff in charge 01, secretarial staff 01, Accounts staff 01, auxiliary staff –lab attendant 01, Dark room attendant 01, Gardening staff 01, Hospital catering 01, Laundry 01, hospital reception staff 01 not available as required.

B. **Hospital Equipment:** Stretcher with trolley 01, Sterilizer 02, Urine pots, male and female 10, Bed pans E.I. 10, Tongue depressor (Disposable) 01, Suction Machine 01, Suction Tube 01, Artery forceps, small and big 02, Oxygen cylinder with stand 02 and Chair trolley with wheels 01 not available as required.

C. **Teaching Staff:**

i. **For undergraduate course, total full time and guest faculty, not mentioned in part -1 but as per provided affidavit 14 are eligible Discrepancies in engagement of teachers are as below:**

a) Dr. Jitendra Kumar Verma (Pharmacy-associate Professor-Contractual full time)-date of joining as Reader: 3/07/2018 but no previous experience as lecturer provided.

b) Dr. Aliya Tanweer (Homoeopathic Materia Medica-Associate Professor- full time)-discrepancy found in date of birth: 1996 and date of passing year of BHMS: 1995, previous experience as lecturer is not provided as date of joining: 25/11/2020.

c) Dr. Ved Prakash Shukla (Lecturer-Homoeopathic Materia Medica -full time) -Affidavit provided but name not mentioned in list.

ii. Not a single guest faculty and part time teacher of Modern Medicine available in the college.

D. **Teaching Department:** Information not available.

E. **Library & Medicinal Plants Garden:** Information not available.

F. **College Laboratories:** As per MSR gross deficiencies observed in all departments. Total 11 items deficient in dept. of Anatomy, 241 items deficient in dept. of Physiology and Biochemistry, 129 items deficient in dept. of Pharmacy, 54 items deficient in dept. of Pathology, 24 items deficient in dept. of Community Medicine and Organon of medicine, 85 items deficient in dept. of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, 12 items deficient in dept. of Repertory and 37 items deficient in dept. of Materia Medica.

G. **Miscellaneous:**

i. Biometric Attendance- Not provided

ii. Salary bank statement-bank statement not provided but total amount under salary is mentioned.

iii. EPF/PF /ESI deductions of teachers, non-teaching staff & hospital staff – no document provided.

iv. Form-16 of teachers, non-teaching staff & hospital staff- no document provided

H. **Website:** Not available.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to **State Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital- Gorakhpur-273402, Uttar Pradesh for 125 seats (including 25 seats under EWS quota) in undergraduate course (BHMS-1) for the academic session year 2021-22. The College Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an undertaking from the Controlling Authority in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.**

4. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions

carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.
