Subject: No Objection Certificate.

Sir,

In continuation to the U.P. Government Order No. 94496-Ayush-2-2018-9 (B)/2007 T.C., Dated 10.05.2018, I have been directed to recommend for the revised number of seats from 60 to 100 in UG for the State Homoeopathic Medical College, Gorakhpur on the basis of the following facts:

- 1- Number of Homoeopathic institutions already existing in the State: Seven (07) under State Government & Three (03) under Private Sector (01PG+01UG+01 UG&PG).
- 2- Number of seats available or number of Homoeopathic practitioners being produced annually: 450 seats for UG&78 seats for P.G.
- 3- Number of Homoeopathic practitioners registered with the State Council/Board of Homoeopathy: 36150 approx.
- 4- Number of Homoeopathic practitioners in State Government service: 1160 Approx.
- 5- Number of vacant Government posts of Homoeopathy doctors in the State, particularly in rural/difficult areas: 450 Approx.
- 6- Number of Homoeopathy doctors registered with the State Employment Exchanges: N.A.

7. Homocopathy doctors-population ratio in the State. 1:6166 approx.
8. How the establishment of the medical college/increase in admission capacity/starting BHMS/M.D(Hom.) course would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State:

Population of the State is above 22.5 crore. Doctor Population ratio is 1:6166 approx. Keeping in view the doctor population ratio, it will be in the public interest to open a new college with 100 seats, so that the aim of better health care in the State is achieved and the large gap of doctor-population ratio is minimised. At present the norms for Homocopathy doctor is one per 1000 people.(as per WHO and 1:1400 as per NTF Ayog)

9. The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified- No

10. Full justification for opening of the proposed Medical College, increase in admission capacity/starting new or higher course: as described on point no- 12

11. Homocopathy doctors-population ratio to be achieved. 1:1000.

12. Government Homocopathic Medical College, Gorakhpur has applied for the establishment of Homocopathy college in District Gorakhpur. After physical verification by a team constituted by Dr. Vinod Kumar Vimal, Director, Homocopathy and on careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Uttar Pradesh has decided to issue 'No Objection Certificate' to the applicant for the establishment of a Homocopathy College with 100 (Hundred) seats intake per annum in first semester year for admission in B.H.M.S. course with a prior condition that the said Government of Uttar Pradesh will fulfil all the prescribed C.C.H. norms. It is further certified that:

- (1) the applicant owns and manages a 25 bedded hospital, which was established in the year 2009.

- (2) it is desirable to establish a Homoeopathy College in the public interest/increase in admission capacity/starting B.H.M.S. course and,
- (3) establishment of Homoeopathy College/increase in admission capacity/starting B.H.M.S. course at Government of Uttar Pradesh Lucknow.
13. It is also certified that adequate clinical materials, equipments, furniture's etc. as per norms of the Central Council of Homocopathy are available with the proposed Medical College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create prescribed infrastructure for the Homoeopathy College as per the Central Council of Homoeopathy norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
